Breakthrough Drug Doubled PFS in ER+ Breast Cancer

In pioneering science, JCCC breast cancer researchers led by Drs. Dennis Slamon and Richard Finn unveiled final results of a phase 2 clinical trial that showed progression-free survival was effectively doubled in women with advanced breast cancer who took the experimental drug palbociclib. 
